This Indenture made this Eleventh day of April one thousand seven hundred and fifty Beleewn Sarah Jackson widow and Mary Peden & Sarah Jackson Daughters of the aforesaid Sarah Jackson of Southampton County of the one part and Benjamin Jenkins of the same County of the other part - Witnesseth that the said Sarah Jackson widow and Mary Peden and Sarah Jackson Daughters as aforesaid for & in consideration of Twelve pounds Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Jenkins at or before the enscaling and Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Sarah Jackson widow and Mary Peden and Sarah Jackson Daughter as aforesaid doth hereby acknowledge them the said Sarah Jackson widow and Mary Peden and Sarah Jackson Daughters as aforesaid hath granted bargained & sold a Line infeofed and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell a Line infeofed and Confirmed unto the said Benj^r Jenkins his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or percell of Land Containing seven five Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in Vottonway Parish in the County of Southampton bounded as follows beginning at the mouth of a branch called Tarrapin up the run of the said branch to a pine thence to a white Oak a corner tree of Tho^s Baykins Land so a long the said line to the Main black water swamp up the run of the said swamp to the mouth of a branch called the Crows branch up the run of the said branch to the Beginning. and all trees woods underwoods
