I know all men by these presents that we Sarah Jackson Widow and my two Daughters Mary Peden & Sarah Jackson of Southampton County are held and firmly bound unto Benjamin Jenkins of the same County or his Attorney Executors administrators or assigns in the full and just sum of one hundred pounds Sterling Money to which payment well and truly to be made we do bind our selves or either of us out or either of our heirs Executors Administrators firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated this 23 day of November in the year of our Lord 1749 anno Domini. whereas Ann Steward grand Daughter to Sarah Jackson Widow & Cozin to Mary Peden & Sarah Jackson as above mentioned has a right to twenty five Acres of Land more or less by the last will & Testament of Richard Jackson
