This Indenture made the 10th day of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty Between
Henry Rose and Mary his wife of the County of Dorsetshire
of the one part & Amos Harris of the County of Southampton
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry Rose &
Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty
pounds Curr.^t money of Virginia to him in hand paid by
the s^d Amos Harris before the Inclosing & delivery hereof
the Receipt whereof the s^d Henry Rose & Mary his wife doth
hereby acknowledge Hath granted bargained & sold and
Doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the
said Amos Harris his heirs and assigns for ever a Certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in Southampton
County aforesaid & on the North side the Three Creeks
Containing by Estimation four hundred & forty Acres.
be the same more or less and bounded as followeth
Vizt
Beginning at a pine by the side of the Fork Branch
thence down the Various Courses of the said branch to a
maple, then North Eighty Degrees West one hundred pole
to a Red oak then South Eighty three Degrees West ten
pole to a pine by the side of the fork branch. then down
the said branch to a Red oak in Joshua Nicholsons Line
then South Sixty Degrees West Sixty four pole to a Gum in
Georges Branch, thence up the Various Courses of the s^d branch
