This Indenture made this 14th day of June Anno: Dom: one thousand seven hundred and fifty between William Edwards and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Henry Blunt of the aforesaid County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Edwards and Elizabeth his wife for & in consideration of the sum of eight pounds Tenn Shillings Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid at or before the Executing and Delivery of the presents the Receipt of which and themselves fully satisfied Contented and paid doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold a Line and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby give grant bargain sell a Line & confirm unto the said Henry Blunt his heirs and assigns for ever one certain tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation seventy Acres be the same more or less situate lying & being in the County aforesaid which said tract or parcel of Land being Conveyed to the said William Edwards by a Deed Recorded in Isle of Wight County Court
