

This Indenture made the 14th day of June in the year of
 our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty Between
 John Bowin of the County of Southampton of the one part
 and William Bulls of the same County of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said John Bowin for and in
 Consideration of the sum of eight pounds Current Money
 of virginia to him in hand paid by the said William
 Bulls before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt
 whereof the said John Bowin doth hereby acknowledge
 hath granted bargained & sold and doth by these pre-
 sents grant bargain and sell unto the said W^m Bulls
 his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land
 lying and being in the County aforesaid Containing one
 hundred & thirteen Acres more or less part of a patten
 for five hundred Sixty five Acres of Land granted to
 Joseph Godwin the 25th day of July 1746 and by the said
 Joseph Godwin sold and conveyed to John Bowin and
 bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at a maple
 on the long branch then down the said branch to
 Barneby M^cquinnys Line then up the said M^cquinnys
 Line to a pine then a Line of mark trees to the beginning
 and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and
 Remainders Rents Issues and profits thereof and all
 the Estate Right title Interest Claim and Demand
 whatsoever of him the said John Bowin and his heirs
 of in or to the same or any part thereof To have and
 to hold the said Land and premises with the
 appurtenances unto the said William Bulls his heirs
 and assigns for ever to the only proper use & behoof of
 of the said William Bulls his heirs & assigns for ever
 and the said John Bowin & his heirs the said Land and
 premises with the appurtenances to the said William
