This Indenture made the 15th day of June in the year of our Lord  
Christ one thousand seven hundred & fifty between Joshua Nichol-  
son of the County of Surry & Parrish of Southwark of the one part  
and John Brewer of Southampton County & Parrish of the other  
part Witnesseth that the said Joshua Nicholson for and in  
consideration of the sum of Forty five pounds Current Money  
to him in hand paid by the said John Brewer the receipt whereof  
he doth hereby discharge the said John Brewer his heirs Executors  
& Administrators acknowledging himself to be therewith fully  
satisfied contented and paid & thereof doth acquit & hath remise  
released and for ever quit claim unto the said John Brewer and by  
these presents for himself and his heirs doth fully and clearly  
& absolutely remise releas and for ever quit claim unto the  
said John Brewer & his heirs for ever all such Right title interest  
and demand whatsoever as he the said Joshua Nicholson had  
or Ought to have had of in or to one hundred & ten Acres of Land  
be the same more or less now in the quiet and peaceable possession  
of the said John Brewer as may more largely appear by Virtue of  
our lease bearing date the day before the date of these presents  
to him the said John Brewer granted by the said Joshua Nichol-  
son situate lying & being in the Parrish & County aforesaid  
on the south side the three Creeks near the head of the broad
