Frank Jack Will Geo. Skiper Watt Bailey John Turner Chief Men of the said Nation by & with the Consent & approbation of Joseph Gray & Thomas Farrell Gent (the said John Simmons being since deceased) testified by their being made parties to these presents in consideration of the sum of fifteen pounds Current Money to the said Trustees in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained & sold alined enfeoffed released & confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain and sell aline enfeoff release & confirm unto the said Richard Pirby junior his heirs and assigns for ever three hundred & ten Acres parcel of the aforesaid Lands as above to be sold & bounded as followeth, to wit, Begining at a white Oak on the head line of the said Nottoway Indians Land by the side of the western Prong thence by the said Indians Line NW 200 poles to a red Oak NE 310 poles to a black Oak SE 144 poles to a gum by the side of Buckhorn Swamp & up the Various Courses of the Swamp to the Begining & also all the Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents & Services thereof & also all the Estate Right title Interest Property Claim & demand whatsoever of the said Nottoway Nation & their Posterity of in & to the said Land & premises & of in & to every part & parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Lands & premises with the appurtenances unto the said Richard Pirby his heirs & assigns for ever Yielding & paying to his Majesty & his Successors the like quit Rents as are paid by Persons obtaining Grants for Land from his Majesty In Witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands & affixed their Seals the Day & year first above Written.
