year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty Between
John Windham of North Carolina of the one part & Sion Hill
of Southampton County in Virginia of the other part Wilms
-eth that for and in consideration of the said Sion Hill bare
-ing equal Charges with the said John Windham in entering
- surveying by the patent fee & all given granted & confirm
- ed & by these Presents doth give grant & confirm unto the said
Sion Hill his heirs & assigns one certain parcel of Land situ
- ate lying and being in Southampton County & containing
fifteen Acres (more or less) which was granted unto the said
John Windham by patent bearing date the fifteenth day of December
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty nine &
bounded as followeth (to wit) Beginning at Sion Hill's crop line
between Hill and Windham thence a long a line of new marked
trees in William Wiggles thence a long Wiggles line to the said
Sion Hill's former line thence along his said line to the begin
- ning together with all woods underwoods ways waters water
courses profits & advantages whatsoever to said parcel of
Land belonging or in any wise appertaining & the reversion
by reversions Remainder & Remainders with all the Estate right
title Interest property Claim & Demand of him the said John
Windham of in or to the premises or any part thereof To
