 joyning to his ~~own~~ Land to the Swethouse Swamp aforesaid
 & down the said Swamp to the mouth of the Long branch at
 the Beginning enclosing ^{eight} Seventy Acres of Land being
 part of a patent granted to Nathaniel Bowck by his ^{honorable} Hugh
 Drisdale which patent bears date the
 Seventeenth day of August in the year of 1725 for every part &
 parcel thereof and also all the Estate Right title Interest claim
