acknowledge and himself to be therewith fully contented  
and paid and thereof and therefrom doth acquit release &  
discharge the said Batholomy Peterson his heirs executors and  
admiritors hath and by these presents doth for himself his heirs  
executors and admiritors grant bargain sell remise release and  
for ever quit claim & confirm unto the said Batholomy  
Peterson and his assigns all that seat tract or parcel of land  
situate lying & being in Southampton County on the North  
side of Neherin River Containing by estimation one hundred  
and twenty Acres of Land more or less and bounded as followeth  
to wit Beginning at a lightwood post a corner of the said  
Peterson Land thence by the said Peterson line North 55° East  
52 pole to a red Oak a corner of Capt. John Puffins Land thence  
by the said Puffins line west by N. 90° pole to a hickory and  
S 15° West 05 pole to a maple a corner of Edwards Land & Land  
thence by the said Landy line S 05° E 32 pole to a maple a corner  
of the said Landy line thence by the said Landy line S 15° W 02  
pole to a red Oak by south 30° W. 44 pole to a red Oak a corner  
of William Newman Land thence by a crooked line of marked  
trees of the said Newmans S. 05° W. 132 pole to a live Oak in
