 Woodward or of my heirs Executors & Assigns and the said Samuel
 Woodward do further Covenant promise grant & agree to &
 with the said Thomas Farrell his heirs Executors and Assigns
 in manner by forme following that is to^{say} that the said Fishing
 place with all Granted Libertys propriety & Emoluments
 unto the said Thomas Farrell Against all persons whatso
 ever claiming or to claim the same by form or under either
 or any of us I shall forever hereafter Warrant and defend
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
