Windham This Indenture made this third Day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty Between John Windham of the County of Tarrill in the Province of North Carolina of the one part & James Lundy of the County of Southampton in the Province of Virginia of the other part Witnesses & Itto that the said John Windom for & in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James Lundy the receipt whereof the said John Windom doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained & sold Aliened Infeoffed and Confirmed by these presents doth Grant Bargain & sell Alien Infeoff and Confirm unto the said James Lundy his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being on the flat swamp in the County of Southampton
