The Condition of this above Obligation is such
that if the above bounden Robt Bryant do for himself
his heirs Executors Admors do in open Court acknowledge
by a Deed his whole Right & title that he or his heirs
shall have unto the Land that was left me in and by
my father Wm. now if the said Robt. & his heirs forever
do from time to time & at all times hereafter forever
never do trouble or mislays demand or Claim any
Right or Interest unto the Land or any part thereof
then is this above Obligation Void & of no Effect but
if the said Robt. Bryant his heirs do ever trouble or
mislay the heirs of said Wm. Bryant in any ways
for the Lands before mentioned this Obligation to be
and remain in full force power & Virtue the Day &
date above Written Witness my hand & seal this
12th day of March 1750/1.
