The Condition of this above Obligation is such  
that if the above bounden Robt. Bryant do for himself  
his heirs <sup>or</sup> Admo<sup>r</sup>s do in open Court acknowledge  
by a Deed his whole Right & title that he or his heirs  
shall have unto the Land that was left me in and by  
my father Will<sup>m</sup> now if the said Robt. & his heirs forever  
do from time to time & at all times hereafter forever  
never do trouble or mislays demand or claim any  
Right or Interest unto the Land or any part thereof  
then is this above Obligation Void & of no Effect but  
if the said Robt. Bryant his heirs do ever trouble or  
mislays the heirs of said W<sup>m</sup>. Bryant in any ways  
for the lands before mentioned this Obligation to be  
and remain in full force power & Virtue the Day &  
date above Written Witness my hand & seal this  
12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1750/1.
