Witnesseth that he the aforesaid Fleet Cooper hath for
in Consideration of the sum of thirty pounds Current
Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Ephraim
Lawrence before the sealing & delivery of these presents
a receipt thereof the said Fleet Cooper doth hereby acknowledge
and of every part and parcel thereof freely clearly & absolutely
acquit & honourate & discharge the aforesaid Ephraim Lawrence
& for Divers other good Causes & Considerations him thereunto moving
hath given granted made over & by these presents do for ever
Confirm unto the said Ephraim Lawrence two certain tracts
and parcels of Land in Southampton County on the west side
Black water River Containing of four Hundred & forty six Acres
according to the bounds & is contained in two patents two
hundred & eighty Acres out of a patent of three hundred & eighty
Acres granted to Richard Williams Deceased & bears date
the 31 day of October 1726 & was divided by the said Richard Williams
his last Will & Testament to his Son Solomon Williams as
