 heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying &  
 being in the County of Southampton on the South Side of  
 Nottonway River bounded as followeth, to wit Beginning  
 at a hickory in William Popes line & running a straight  
 course to the Nicer branch & down the said branch to
