Indenture

This Indenture made the 10th Day of April in the Year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty one Between Jacob Pope
by the Consent of Patience his wife of the County of Edgecomb of the
one part & Benj: Faircloth of the County of Southampton of the
other Part witnesseth that the said Jacob Pope for and in considera-
tion of the sum of twenty five Pounds Current Money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said Benj: Faircloth the receipt
whereof the said Jacob Pope doth hereby acknowledge Hath
granted bargained by sold aliened in scoffed & confirmed by
by these presents Doth grant bargain & sell Alene in scoff
& confirm unto the said Benj: Faircloth his heirs & Assign
forever one certain tract or Parcel of Land lying by being
in the County of Southampton aforesaid on the South side
of Holloway River containing by Estimation one hundred
and Ninety Acres let the same be more or less bounded as
followeth, to wit, Beginning at a gum on the East side
of the Sweathouse Swamp below the mouth of the woolspit
Branch then East by North one hundred & thirty two pole to
a pine then to the said woolspit Branch & down the said
Branch to a poplar a corner tree in the Dividing line then
to a pine next to a red oak a corner tree then to a pine
next to another pine then down a small branch to a white
