This Indenture made the twenty eighth Day of August in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & fifty Between
William Spence of Southampton County of the one part & Elizabeth
Machlemore of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesse
that the said William Spence for & in consideration of the love
& tender affections he bares for his Daughter Elizabeth Mach-
lemore aforesaid Hath given granted & confirmed unto the
said Elizabeth Machlemore her heirs & assigns forever one
certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in
Southampton County on the North side of a branch called
Franks Branch containing eighty Acres more or less &
bounded as followeth, to wit Beginning at Franks Branch
thence along Thomas Cliftons Line to a Black Oak by the side
William Spence for a Division thence lastely along a line of
marked trees to John Calthorps line thence along Calthorps
Line to Franks Branch aforesaid thence along Franks Branch
to the Beginning being part of a Tract of Land granted to
said William Spence by Patent bearing date the fifth day of
September one thousand seven hundred & forty nine together
with all woods underwoods Gardens Orchards ways waters
water Courses profits Commodities & advantages whatsoever
to the said tract or parcel of Land & premises with the
appurtenances belonging or in any Appurtenances
the Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders with
all the Estate Right title Interest property Claim & demand
of him the said William Spence of in or to the premises or any
part thereof To have and to hold the said tract or Division
of Land & all & singular the premises herein before mention
or intended to be hereby granted with the appurtenances
