JUNE the 7<sup>th</sup> 1745 This Day Lawrence Lancaster of Isle of Wight County in Nottoway Parish and Solomon Delph of the County and Parish aforesaid did Peaceably and quietly Divide the Land that formerly did belong to Edward Moreland Deceased and did Run a Line between us which Line we Oblige our selves our Heirs & Exors and Admors in the Penalty of fifty pounds Current Money of Virginia shall stand forever for which paymen well and truly to be made we bind our selves our Heirs & Exors by these Presents In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and fixt our seals the Day and year above Written

The Quantity of Land falling to Solomon Delph by the Judgment of us whose names are Subscribed As Witnesses to the above Agreement is Eighty five Acres.
