This Indenture made this ninth day of May Anno Dom^o one thousand seven hundred & fifty one Between Richard Vick of the County of Southampton of the one part & John Underwood of the County aforesaid of the other part Witneseth that the said Richard Vick for and in consideration of the Sum of Tenn pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid at or before the Insealing & Delivery of these presents the Receipt of which and himself fully satisfied Contented & paid he doth hereby acknowledge both granted Bargained and sold Aliened and Confirmed by these presents doth Give Grant Bargain and Sell Alien & Confirm unto the said John Underwood his heirs & Assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing eighty Acres lying & being on the south side of Mottoway River in the County aforesaid which said Tract or parcel of Lands was granted to the said Richard Vick by a patent bearing date the Eleventh Day of June one thousand seven hundred & thirty one Preference being thereunto had will more fully and clearly appear and bounded as followeth, To Wit, Beginning at a Gum on the East side of Cox's branch a Corner Tree of the Land lately belonging to William Edwards Deed Thence by Edwards's lines North Sixty Six Degrees East Thirty Six pole to a Lead Oak, South East twenty pole to a Lead Oak, thence North fifty one Degrees East twenty seven pole to a Pine thence North five Degrees West one

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
