This Indenture Tripartite made the Day of September in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & forty nine Between Frank Roger Sam^r D^r Tom^r Matt^r Cherino Sciper Jack Will John Turner Chief Men of the Nottoway Indian Nation of the first part Joseph Gray and Thomas Farrell Gent Surviving Trustees of the County of Southampton of the second part of Etheldred Taylor of the same County of the third part Whereas by one Act of Assembly made at a Session lately held at Williamsburg in the twenty second Year of the Reign of our Lord George the second King of Great Britain & Intituled an Act to enable the Nottoway Indians to Sell certain Lands and for other purposes therein mentioned It is amongst other things Enacted that the Chief Men of the Nottoway Nation are Impowered by and with the Consent and Approbation of John Simmons Joseph Gray of Thomas Farrell Gent the Survivors or Survivor of them who are hereby appointed Trustees to see this Act duly executed to Sell & Convey the remaining part of their said Lands being three thousand Acres or thereabouts lying between the Western boundary of their said Land and Buckhorn Swamp ^{not} as to include any part of the said Main Swamp for the best price that can be got and after any Agreement made for the sale of the same or any parts thereof it shall if may be Lawfull for the Chief Men of the said Nation together with the Trustees aforesaid or the Survivors or Survivor of them to deal & Deliver any Deed or Deeds Indented for the Conveyance of the Fee Simple and Inheritance of the said Lands to the Purchaser who immediately after the Execution of such Deed or Deeds shall pay down
