This Indenture made this 11 Day of July in the year of our Lord 1751 Between William Deloach of the County of South Hampton of the one part & John Oney & Benj. Oney of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Deloach for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Pounds Curr. Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Oney & Benj. Oney before the sealing & delivering hereof the receipt whereof the said W^m Deloach doth hereby acknowledge & hath granted Bargained & sold & doth by these presents grant Bargain & sell unto the said John Oney & Benj. Oney their heirs & assigns a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County aforesaid containing two hundred acres granted to Thos. Deloach in a patent bearing date the fifth day of September one thousand seven hundred & forty nine & bounded as followeth (Wizt) Beginning at a Poplar on the West side of the north prong of the Horsepen Branch thence North west by west one hundred & forty one Poles to a pine then South west by west one hundred & twenty seven poles to a pine by the side of the west prong of the Horsepen Branch aforesaid then down the various Courses of the Run of the said West prong to the North prong aforesaid

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
