Sen^r of the said County of the other part Witnesse^teth that the
said J^o. Cobb for and in Consideration of the sum of five
Shillings Current Money of Virginia to him in hand hath
granted Bargained sold Aliened Infeoffed & Consigned by
these Presents doth grant bargain sell alien Infeoffe^d & Consign
unto the said William Hartfield and his Heirs forever a
certain Tract or parcel of Land lying in their County aforesaid
Containing by Estimation fifty acres be the same more or
less the said Dividend of Land being part of a patent
granted to J^o. Cobb aforesaid bearing Date November the
third one thousand seven hundred & fifty in the twenty four
year of our Reign & bounded as followeth Beginning
at a pine by the side of Dick's Swamp a corner of W^m Hartfield's
Gurley's Land thence by the said Gurley's Line to a prong
of the said Swamp thence down the said Prong of the
swamp to the Swamp aforesaid thence up the said course
of the run of the said swamp to the Beginning with all
Woods Underwoods Common Commons of Pastures profits
commodities Advantages Impliments & Hereditaments ~
whatsoever to the Tract of Land belonging or in any way
appertaining or upon the same growing happening or
arising & also the Reversion Reversionary remainder &
remainders rents Services of the premises & every part
thereof To have and to hold all and singular the said
premises abovementioned & every part & parcel thereof
with the appurtenances unto the said W^m Hartfield and his
Heirs to the only proper use & behoof of the said W^m Hartfield
