and bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine on the South
side of the Beaversdam Swamp just below the mouth of
a small branch thence south East by the Courses of the pattern
a made corner tree a pine thence by a line of marked trees to the
head of small branch thence down the various Courses of the
said branch to a pine in a Meadow a corner tree of the said
Cobb's other Land thence N. West to the side of the Beaversdam
Swamp aforesaid thence up the Courses of the swamp to the
beginning concluding the part of the first pattern then begin
nings with the second pattern at a pine on the South Side of
Dicks Swamp a corner Tree of John Braswells Land thence by
Braswells Lines South Eighty five Degrees East twenty seven
Pole to a pine & South forty Degrees East one hundred & forty
five Pole to a White oak a corner of Wm Sellers Land thence by
Sellers Lines East North East one hundred & thirty six pole to
a pine a line tree of Doctor Brown's Land thence by Browns
Lines North West by North six pole to a red Oak thence North
Thirty Degrees West eleven Poles to a Maple in the mouth of a
Morey branch on the South Side of Dicks Swamp aforesaid
and up the various Courses of the run of the said Swamp to the
beginning with all trees Woods underwoods Common Comoners
of pastures profits Commodities Advantages Implements
and Appurtenances to the Tracts of Land belonging or in any
ways appertaining or upon the same growing happening
or arising and also the reversion Reversions Remainder
and Remainders rents services of the premises of every part
hereof to have and to hold above singular the said
Premises abovementioned by every part and parcel thereof
with the appurtenances unto the said Joseph Cobb just and
his Heirs to the only proper use & behoof of the said Joseph Cobb
and his Heirs forever by the said Benj Brown Ann Wombwell
Widow by Mary Wombwell Widow for themselves & their Heirs
the said Lands & premises & every part thereof against them
and their Heirs forever and against all by every other
