by the said James Barham before the sealing and Delivery hereof
The Receipt whereof the said J^r. Briggs and Frances his Wife
doth hereby acknowledge That Granted Bargained & Sold
and Doth by these Presents Grant Bargain and sell unto the said
James Barham his Heirs and Assigns forever; a certain Tract
or Parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
aforesaid and on the North side the Three Creeks containing by
Estimation Two hundred & Forty five Acres be the same more or less
the said Land being two Patents Granted to James Hammon the one
bearing Date February 21 one thousand seven hundred & Twenty in
the seventh year of his Majesty's Reign the other Augth the 20th one
thousand seven hundred & forty five in the Nineteenth year of
his Reign as by the Patents more fully and at Large appears
the said Two hundred & Forty five Acres of Land being bounded as
followeth Viz^t Beginning at a red Oak over the Ridge of the
Needson the North West side of the Three Creeks thence North Fifty
three Degrees East one hundred & fifty six Pole to a Crooked Pine
then North eighteen Degrees East seventy two Pole to a Pine then
North West by West seventy four Pole to a Pine near a Branch then
South West by West one hundred and Twenty Pole to a sloping Red Oak

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
