This Indenture made this eighth day of October in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred fifty one and in the Twenty fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Between Jacob Pope of the County of Edgecomb in the Province of North Carolina & Joseph Newsom of the County of Southampton in Virginia Executors of William Pope Deceased of the aforesaid County and Province of North Carolina of the one part & Benjamin Crocher of Southampton in Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Jacob Pope & Joseph Newsom for and in consideration of the Sum of twenty one Pounds two & Nine Pence Curr^t Money of Virginia to the said Jacob Pope & Joseph Newsom in hands paid by the said Benj. Crocher the Receipt whereof the said Jacob Pope & Joseph do hereby acknowledge They the said Jacob Pope & Joseph Newsom have granted Bargained and Sold Alien'd & Confirm'd by these Presents do Grant Bargain'd Sell Alien & Confirm unto the said Benjamin Crocher his Heirs & Assigns forever Two Seats Tracts or parcels of Land Situate

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
