This Indenture made the 13th Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty one Between Thomas Jones Sen^r of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Jones jun^r of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Jones Sen^r for and in Consideration of the Sum of thirty Pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Jones jun^r before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said Thomas Jones Sen^r doth hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained and sold and doth hereby these presents Grant Bargain & Sell unto the said Thomas Jones jun^r his heirs and assigns a certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid Containing one hundred & Sixty Acres part of a patten for four hundred and forty Acres of Land granted to Tho^s Jones the ninth day of July 1724 and Bounded as followeth
Beginning at a Gum on the South side of Secock Swamp then a Line of market Trees to a hickory a Corner of William Jones Land then the said William Jones Line to a Branch then up the
