Nash for and in Consideration of the Sum of Fifteen Pounds
Current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said
Benjamin Bradshaw before the Sealing & Delivery hereof the
Receipt whereof the said Joseph Bradshaw & Joseph Nash doth
hereby acknowledge That he granted Bargained and Sold and
Doth by these presents Grant Bargain & Sell unto the said Benj
Bradshaw his Heirs and Assigns forever a Certain Tract or
Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid
Containing Eighty Acres granted to Joseph Bradshaw in a
Patent bearing date the thirtieth day of August one thousand
seven hundred and forty four and Bounded as by the said
Patent may fully and at Large appear and the Reversion

thereof and all the State Right Title Interest Claim and Demand
whatsoever of them the said Joseph Bradshaw and Joseph Nash
