This Indenture made the tenth Day of August one thousand seven hundred & fifty one in the twenty fourth year of his Majesty's Reign by the Grace of God of Great Britain France Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Between John Morgan of Nottoway Parish in Surrey County on the one part & Thomas Ammon of Nottoway Parish of Southampton County on the other part Witnesseth that the said John Morgan doth give & bequeath to the said Thomas Ammon for the use & sealing & delivering these presents the Receipt whereof the said John Morgan doth confess acknowledge for himself his Heirs &c thereof and every of them doth Acquit and Discharge and by these presents hath granted given & bequeathed in full & confirmed & by these presents doth fully grant give and bequeath the same unto Thomas Ammon his Heirs &c one certain Tract of Land to Contain one hundred Acres be it more or less unto in his peaceable Possession Situated lying & being in Surrey County on the South side of Nottoway River & bounded by a Dividing line as followeth (viz) Beginning at a pine on the South side of the Hogbed branch running last to a Dividing Corner and oak then South last to a Great Pine of Thomas Adams jun<sup>r</sup> line then keeping the said Adams Line to a great Gum on the North side of Bear branch running up the said branch to a lightwood knott so keeping the old line to the Beginning To have and to Hold the said Land & Premises with all Appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Thomas Ammon his Heirs &c forever and the said John Morgan for himself his Heirs &c to the said Land & Premises above given with the Appurtenance unto the said Thomas Ammon his Heirs &c Against him the said John Morgan his Heirs against all Persons or person whatsoever from by & under him or them shall defend by these presents shall be lawfully seized in fee simple of the said Land & Premises & every part thereof without any Condition power of Revocation or Limitation to alter Change or Determine or make Void the same & good right full power in the same to give bequeath Confirm the same & every part thereof with the

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
