This Indenture made the 12th Day of March in the Year of our Lord
One thousand seven hundred & fifty two Between Joseph Jones of the
County of Southampton of the one Part & Lewis Joyner of the same
County of the other Part Witneseth that the said Joseph Jones for & in
Consideration of the sum of eight pounds Current Money of Virginia
to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Joyner before the sealing & delivery
hereof the receipt whereof the said Joseph Jones doth hereby acknowledge
Hath granted bargained & sold & doth hereby these presents grant
bargain & sell unto the said Lewis Joyner his heirs and assigns a
certain Tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County of Southam-
pton and on Black Creek Swamps Containing fifty Acres more
or less being part of a patent for one hundred Acres of land granted to
John Dawson in the year of our Lord 1720 & bounded as followeth -
Beginning at the Mouth of Cains Branch up the lower prong of the
said branch to the Head Line & up the said Line to Black Creek & down the
Run of the said Creek to the Beginning being the Plantation & land
the said Jo. Jones purchased of Wm Lucas & the Reversion & Reversions
Remainder & Remainder Rents Issues & Profits thereof and all the
estate Right Title Interest Claim & demand whatsoever of him the
Joseph Jones & his Heirs of in or to the same or any Part thereof To have
and to hold the said Land & premises with the appurtenances unto
the said Lewis Joyner his heirs & assigns forever & the said Jo. Jones & his
heirs the said Land & premises with the appurtenances to the said Lewis
Joyner his heirs & assigns shall & will warrant & forever defend by these
presents In Witness whereof the said Jo. Jones have hereunto set his
Hand & Seal the day & year first above written
