Beginning at a live Oak in Antons Delight & running up the Delight
to a pine a corner Tree in the said Land then running an East course
to a Gum standing in a Branch that makes out of the Delight then
down the said Branch to the Mouth of the Spring Branch then up the
Spring Branch to a pine standing in Divideing Line between the
said Land & the Land of James Readers then a long the said Line to a
Gum from thence to the live Oak aforesaid for one hundred Acres of
