& Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the Sum of Five pounds
Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said W^m Cumpley
just before the sealing & delivery hereof the Receipt whereof the said W^m
Cumpley fent & Doth hereby acknowledge Hath granted bargained
& sold & Doth by these presents grant bargain & sell unto the said William
Cumpley j^r his heirs & Assigns forever A certain Tract or Parcel of
Land Situate lying & being on the South side of Black Water Swamp in
the County of Southampton Containing one hundred & sixty five Acres
be the same more or less Beginning at a pine at Tuckers Bay thence
to a white Oak a Corner Tree of James Rigbys Land thence to a pine standing
in a Meadow so along to James Rigbys line again to a white Oak by Rigbys
line to a white Oak a Corner Tree of Joseph Powells by the said line to a
branch called the Deep Branch to a pine Tree of John Cumpleys thence
along the said line to a Maple in a small Branch down the said branch
to the main Black Water Swamp down the said Swamp to the beginning
