This Indenture made this Twelf Day of November in the  
Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Two  
the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and  
Ireland King Defender of the faith &c Between William Barns  
and Sarah his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part  
and John Bittle of the County aforesaid of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said William Barns and Sarah his wife  
for and in Consideration of the sum of fifty five pounds Seventeen  
Shillings current money of Virginia to the said William Barns  
in hand paid by the said John Bittle the Receipt whereof the said  
William Barns and Sarah his wife do hereby acknowledge they  
the said William Barns and Sarah his wife have granted  
Bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these  
presents do Grant Bargain and sell alien and confirm unto  
the said John Bittle his heirs and assigns for ever one Seat  
tract or Parcel of Land Situate lying and being on the South  
Side of Nottoway River in the County of Southampton

Aforesaid containing three Hundred and seven acres be the  
same more or less and Bounded as followeth to wit Beginning  
at a pine in William Barns's line on the South side of the  
West prong of Buckhorn Swamp thence Northwardly to a  
white oak on the Northside of the said prong thence Eastward-  
ly down the Edge of the low grounds of the said West prong to  
a persimmon thence Southwardly across the said prong to a  
hickory in the said William Barns's line thence west-  
wardly to the Beginning and also the Reversion and  
Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues  
and Services of the said premises and of every part and  
Parcel thereof and all the Estate Right Title Interest
