This Indenture made this Ninth Day of July one Thousand
Seven Hundred and fifty Two and in the twenty fifth year of
the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace
of God of Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the faith
Between Jesse Browne of Nottoway Parish and County of
Southampton of the one part and James Daughtry of the parish
and county aforesaid of the other part part Witnesseth that the
said Jesse Browne for in consideration of the sum of Ten Pounds
current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James
Daughtry at or before the Insealing and Delivering of these
presents the Receipt whereof the said Jesse Browne doth hereby
acknowledge he the said Jesse Browne hath granted Bargained
and sold aliened enfeofed and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant Bargain and sell alien enfeofe and confirm unto the
said James Daughtry his heirs and assigns forever one hundred
and forty eight acres of Land Part of a Tract or parcel of Land
granted unto Doct. Samuel Browne by the Honourable Hugh
Tisdale Esquir &c containing one Hundred and fifty Acres
Two Acres only excepted and that Lying and joyning Black
Water Swamp and opper sit to the mouth of King Sale Swamp
the said Two Acres excepted to the said Jesse Browne and his
heirs the Residue being one hundred and forty eight Acres
more or Less according to patent Lying and being in the
aforesaid county and Boundeth as followeth Beginning at
a Hickory by the Side of the said Blackwater Swamp Stand-
ing in the county Line Between Isle of wright now Southam-
pton and Nansemond county's thence by the county Line
South Sixty Degrees west three hundred and four pole to a
pine then North Ten Degrees east fifty two pole to a pine
then North thirty Degrees west forty pole to a pine then
