thousand seven hundred and fifty two Between Benjamin  
Crocker and by the Consent of Sarah his wife of the County of Southamp-  
ton of the one part and Jeremiah Edmunds of the Same County of  
the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Crocker for  
an inconsideration of the sum of twenty Shillings Currant money  
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Jeremiah Edmunds  
where with the said Benjamin Crocker doth here by acknowledge  
himself there with fully Satisfied Consented and paid  
and thereby acquit and Discharge the said Jeremiah Edmunds  
his heirs Executors and assigns and I the aforesaid  
Benjamin Crocker doth here by bargain sell Infect and Conform  
unto the said Jeremiah Edmunds a certain tract or parcell of  
Land lying and being in the County of Southampton by esti-  
-mation one hundred acres of Land more or less on the South-  
-side of Notoway River it being part of a patent of three  
hundred and forty acres granted to Benjamin Crocker by his  
honourable Thomas Lee which patent bearing Date the fif-  
-teenth Day of December 1749 and Bounded as followeth to  
Wit beginning at a small white oak and thence along Line of  
marked trees to a red oak thence along a line to the Little  
Swamp to a pine then up the various Courses of the run of the
