hold after my Decease to her and her Heirs I give unto
my Daughter Mary Dren a Negro Girl named Jenny to
have and to hold after my Decease to her and her Heirs
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal this thirteenth Day of August Anno Domini
One thousand seven hundred and fifty two.
