Bailey This Indenture made the second Day of March in the  
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty two  
Between Roger Delk of Surry County of the one part and  
Benjamin Bailey of Southampton County of the other part  
Witnesseth that the said Roger Delk for and in consideration  
of the sum of Eighteen pounds current money to him in hand  
paid by the said Benjamin Bailey the Receipt whereof the said  
Roger Delk doth hereby acknowledge he the said Roger Delk  
hath granted Bargained and sold Aliened Infeoffed and con-  
-formed and by these presents doth grant Bargain and sell alien  
Infeoff and confirm unto the said Benjamin Bailey his heirs  
and assigns forever a certain Tract or parcel of Land contain-  
ing one hundred & forty acres Lying and being in the County  
of Southampton on the south side of the main Blackwater  
Swamp and Bounded as followeth beginning at a pine a  
corner of John Halliman and Thomas Hallimans Land  
thence by Thos. Hallimans Line to a Red oak thence by  
Hallimans Line to a pine thence by Hallimans Line to a  
Red oak thence a Long aline to a Lightwood Stake in Benj<sup>n</sup>  
Pitmans Line thence a Long aline of mark'd trees to a  
stake in Joseph griffins Line thence to a pine in Robt.  
Meyers Land thence to Red oak thence to a oak thence to
