

This Indenture made the first Day of August
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
 fifty two by and between Lazarus Johnson of the Isle of
 Wight County in Virginia Planter of the one part & Jesse
 Johnson of Same County planter of the other part Wit-
 nessed that the said Lazarus Johnson for and in the con-
 sideration of the Just sum of Nineteen pounds current
 money of Virginia in hand paid and satisfied hath
 bargained granted and sold Infeoffed and confirmed
 and by these presents Doth absolutely give grant
 bargain Sell Alien Infeoff and Confirm unto the said
 Jesse Johnson his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 Tract of Land containing two hundred and fifteen acres
 lying and being on the South Side of Black Water River
 in Southampton County and granted to the aforesaid
 Lazarus Johnson by a deed of Sale bearing Date the
 twenty Seventh Day of June 1743 from Thomas Drake and
 bounded as followeth Beginning at a pine on the North
 Side of the Ready branch thence North forty Degrees East
 one hundred and twenty two pole to a black oak thence North
 five Degrees west one hundred and eighty three pole to
 a pine then South Seventy Degrees west one hundred &
 twenty six pole to a pine then South Sixty two Degrees west
 twenty five pole to a pine by the side of the Indianfield
 branch a corner tree of Giles Drivers Land then by
 Drivers Line South forty Degrees East one hundred and
 six pole to a red oak then South Seventy five Degrees
 west Sixty Eight pole to a pine then South forty Degrees
 west Eighty Eight pole to a hickory a line tree of Thomas
 Drake then by the said Drake's line East South East Eighty
 five pole to a red oak then South South west thirty eight
 pole to a white oak by the side of the Ready branch afore-
 said and by the main Run of the said branch to the beginning
 with all and singular the Rights hereditaments appurtenan-
 ces and appendants whatsoever to the said Land and in
