^{Jones} This Indenture made this Ninth Day of November one Thousand Seven Hundred fifty & two and in the twenty fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c between Richard Vick of Southampton County of the one part and Albrington Jones of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Vick for and in Consideration of the sum of four pounds Six Shillings current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Albrington Jones at and before the insealing and Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof the said Richard Vick doth hereby acknowledge he the said Richard Vick hath granted Bargained and sold aliened enfeofed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeof and confirm unto the said Albrington Jones his heirs and assigns forever Six Acres of Land part of a tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred acres the same sold to the said Richard Vick by William Branswell & Joseph Branswell and joining to the said Albrington Jones's Mill and Boundeth as followeth To wit Beginning at a Sweet Gum on the edge of the main Nottoway Swamp Standing on the North side of the Bridge over the said Swamp Below the mill from thence to a
