six shillings currant money of Virginia to him in hand paid by

Delivering of These presents the Receipt whereof the said Rich.
Vick doth hereby acknowledge he the said Richard Vick hath
granted Bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and
by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alienenfeoff and
confirm unto the said Albridgeon Jones his heirs and assigns
forever six acres of Land part of a tract or parcel of Land
containing one hundred acres the same sold to the said Rich.

to the said Albridgeon Jones's Mill and Boundeth as followeth
