and thereof & of every part & parcel thereof do fully and
clearly and absolutely acquit Exonerate and discharge
the aforesaid John Johnson his heirs & executors adm^r or assigns
by these presents and for divers other good Causes and Consi
derations him thereunto moving the said John Denson his
heirs & executors adm^r forever bargain sold and forever confirm
ed unto John Johnson his heirs two hundred acres of Land
more or less Situate lying and being in Nottonway parish
