afores<sup>d</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> other part witnesseth that y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Hodges  
Counsell for & in Consideration of y<sup>e</sup> sum of five pounds  
Current Money of Virginia to be paid by y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John  
Counsell at or before y<sup>e</sup> sealing or delivery of these presents  
the Receipt whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Hodges Counsell doth hereby  
acknowledge and hereof doth warrant part or parcel  
thereof do hereby fully and freely acquit and discharge  
y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Counsell and himself therewith to be fully  
Satisfied Contented and have given granted bargained  
Sold alienated Enfeoffed and by these presents do  
give grant Bargain sell alienate Enfeoff confirm to  
John Counsell his heirs & assigns forever one parcel of  
Land containing by Estimation seventyfore acres of  
Land more or Less bounded as followeth to wit begin-  
ning at y<sup>e</sup> mouth of y<sup>e</sup> Line branch that divides  
between me & Francis Denson so up y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> branch to  
y<sup>e</sup> head so along a line of marked trees to y<sup>e</sup> outside line  
a pine corner tree between Denson and I then Eastward  
upon that line to boons branch then down y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> branch to a  
gum corner then west a line of marked trees to a poplar  
in a small branch & down that to y<sup>e</sup> Line branch before  
mentioned y<sup>e</sup> first station the said Land was by patent  
granted to John Denson the Elder by Alexander Hottelwood
