heirs Executors and Administrators hath granted Bargained
Sold Aliened Infeoffed Confirmed and made over unto the said
Edward Windham his heirs or assigns forever and by these Presents
doth Grant Bargain Sell Aliene Infeoff Confirm and make over unto
the said Edward Windham his heirs and assigns forever one certain
Tract or Parcel of Land Situate lying and being in Southampton
County aforesaid Containing two Hundred and Seventy acres of
Land the same more or less being Granted to the said Francis
Sharp by Patent Bearing Date at Williamsburg the Sixteenth
