 presents the Receipt whereof the said Isaac Mason doth hereby
 acknowledge he the s^d Isaac Mason hath Granted Bargained
 and sold aliened Infeoffed and confirmed & by these presents
 doth Grant Bargain and Sell alien Infeoffed and confirm unto
 the said Rich^d Hamlin his Heirs and assigns forever a certain
 Tract or parcel of Land containing by Estimation one hundred &
 ninety Acres more or less situate lying and being in Nottoway
 Parish & County aforesaid and bounded as followeth Beginning
 at a white Oak thence north to a white Oak thence North East to a
 Black Oak in Sargus Jones's line thence along the s^d Jones's
 line North by west to a white Oak thence North by west to three trees
 Chopped Inwards thence North East to a pine thence North East to a
