This Indenture made the thirteenth Day of July One thousand seven hundred and fifty three Between William Taylor of the Parish of Nottoway and County of Southampton Planter of the one part and Etheldred Taylor of the Parish and County aforesaid Gent of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Taylor for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five Pounds to him in hand paid by the said Etheldred Taylor at or before the sealing and Delivery of these Presents the Receipt whereof the said William Taylor doth here by acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Etheldred Taylor his Heirs Executors & Admors forever by these Presents the said William Taylor hath granted Bargained Sold Aliened Released and confirmed and by these Presents doth Grant Bargain Sell Alien Release and Confirm unto the said Etheldred Taylor his Heirs and Assigns forever all that the said William Taylor his Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land situate lying and being on the South Side of Nottoway River on the lower side of the Three Creeks in the Parish & County aforesaid being half of seven Hundred and Fifty Acres of Land Purchased of Christopher Hillbee by William Hitchen dead and by him devised to his Son Matthew Hitchen & by him (by his Last Will and Testament) devised to the said William Taylor in Fee Simple the said Plantation Tract or Parcel of Land containing three Hundred & Seventy five Acres more or less and now in the Tenure and Occupation of the said Etheldred Taylor Together with all Houses Outhouses Edifices buildings

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
