Rivers his heirs and assigns for ever during the natural life of
Polly Bass wife of Demory Bass, who was the widow and wife
of John Thap and a piece of land of Land, it being the said
Polly's dower in his former wife's husband John Thap's land, con-
-ing eighty seven and better some more of Acre and some of land
beginning at the Run of the Stone Creek in the line dividing the land
belonging to the estate of John Thap which was left to his
widow
