wrote the 23rd day of September 1795 did sell and convey unto John

the payment of twenty pounds seven shillings and eight pence
with Interest thereon justly due to the said John Davis as
Administrator of the said Isaac Williams dec^d. from the said
Mossey Kirby, Also for Securing to Isaac Denson Esq^r: the
payment of Twenty nine Pounds eight shillings and three
pence with growing Interest thereon and whereas the said
Mossey Kirby said his assigns have nearly discharge the first
mentioned bond and wholly paid off and satisfied Isaac
Denson Esq^r: Now know ye that I the said John Davis Administrator
of the said Isaac Williams dec^d. and trustee for Isaac
Denson Esq^r: for the consideration aforesaid, have and by these
presents do remise release and forever quit claim unto
the aforesaid Mossey Kirby and to his heirs and assigns
all the right title interest claim and demand of him
the said John Davis his Admin^r or assigns either as Admin^r
of the said Isaac Williams dec^d. and as trustee of Isaac
Denson Esq^r: or otherwise of or unto the aforesaid property
mentioned to be conveyed in and by the aforesaid deed in trust
herein before mentioned and I do here by Acquite and discharge
the said Mossey Kirby his heirs Admin^r and assigns from
the said debt and demands of the said John Davis Admin^r Esq^r:
