 Banister for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds current
 money of Virginia to him in hand by the said Nathaniel Williams
 at or before the sealing and signing hereof the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and by these presents
 with fully and absolutely granted bargain sold and confirmed to
 him the said Nathaniel Williams his heirs and assigns all that right
 title interest and claim of what so ever of lands lying and being in the parish aforesaid containing
 three full acres more or less and bounded as followeth (to wit)
 beginning at a post oak in Jacob Williams tract or
