and sell unto the said Benjamin W. Johnston
and to his Heirs and assigns forever all that tract or
piece of land which the said Thomas Porter purchased
of ~~Benj. W. Johnston~~ John Brooks containing by
a late survey one hundred and twelve acres of the
same more or less by reference to the said
John Brooks to the said Porter - the Boundaries
and lines will fully appear - To have and
to hold the said land houses orchards and every other
of the premises unto him the said Benj. W.
Johnston his heirs and assigns forever against
the claim of him the said Thomas Porter and
his wife his Heirs or assigns and against the
claim and demand of all and every other person
or persons whatsoever - In Witness whereof
the said Thomas Porter hath hereunto set his
hand and affixed his seal this aforesaid 19th day
May 1872 -
