 in the year of our lord Christ 1803 Between Henry Jones & Elizabeth
 Jones his Wife of the County of Southampton of the one part & Daniel
 Simmons of the same parish and County of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said Henry Jones & Elizabeth his Wife for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Fifty eight pounds five shillings lawful
 money of to him in hand paid by the said Daniel Simmons
 the receipt whereof the said Henry Jones & Elizabeth his Wife
 do hereby acknowledge themselves sufficiently satisfied and
 paid, doth Grant Bargain and have sold Alien and Con-
 firm unto the said Daniel Simmons his heirs &c.

Part of a certain tract or parcel of Land & tenements belonging
 to the orphan of Thomas Tynes dec'd & sold by a decree of the
 Court, the above mentioned tract or parcel of land lying
